

Marsh Harbour Property Owners Association Emergency Procedures

DIAL 911 for FIRE– POLICE and AMBULANCE

Emergency procedures for Marsh Harbour Property Owners Association include a multi-layer approach depending on the nature of the emergency. The primary concern is for the safety and security of Marsh Harbour POA residents.

Non-Emergency: For non-emergency situations such as vandalism, loud or obnoxious parties, abandoned cars, etc., contact the Kingsland Police Department at (912) 729-8254. Stray or dangerous animals contact Camden County Animal Control at (912) 576-7395.

Destructive Weather: Destructive weather includes severe thunderstorms, hurricane, tornado, and flood. It is highly recommended that Marsh Harbour POA residents register for Code Red notifications through the following link [Camden County Code Red Registration Form](#) and have a personal destructive weather plan. Evacuation: In the event that residents of Camden County are ordered to evacuate it is a good idea to have a family evacuation plan. Plan how you will leave, and where you will go. Also be familiar with evacuation routes, including alternate routes. Additional information, including Evacuation Routes, can be found on the Camden County Web site.
